OVERVIEW

The camp is a NON-CONTACT skills camp, teaching basic football fundamentals and technique. The camp will last for two days. Throughout the camp, the campers will be given a chance to practice an offensive position and a defensive position. They will also be able to try a special-teams position such as punter, kicker, long snapper, and holder. At the end of each day, all campers will compete in a 7 on 7 passing tournament. All groups and teams will be divided appropriately by age.

CAMP STAFF

The camp staff will be made up of the Whitehall High School football coaching staff. Each position group will also have current Norsemen football players to help assist the campers. If schedules permit, former WHS football players currently playing college football may be present at the camp.

LOCATION-FACILITY

The camp will be held at the Whitehall Football game field/track facility. Depending upon the number of campers, the football practice field may also be used.

This camp is open to all students entering 1st through 5th grades.
